TRANSFER OF STORAGE CROP DELIVERY ALLOCATION

The transfer of Delivery Allocation between storage crops producers or prospective producers occurs only once a year.

In order that Delivery Allocation transfers are completed prior to the start of the new crop year the application deadline, is February 14.

An application for transferring Delivery Allocation is to be received by the VMC by the filing deadline. To make application the parties involved are to use the prescribed form.
