The British Columbia Vegetable Marketing Commission General Order of March 16 2005, as amended, is further amended as follows:

Section 2 and 3 of Part II – Books and Records – of the General Order is repealed and replaced with the following:

2. For the purposes of ascertaining whether the Orders, rules and regulations of the Commission are being complied with, every Person shall, upon request, produce for inspection by the Commission or any member of the Commission, or any of its employees, or any other Person authorized by the Commission for that purpose, all such books and records kept by that Person.
3. Every Person shall, upon request, furnish to the Commission any information relating to the production, grading, Processing and Marketing by that Person, of the Regulated Product and shall make specific answers to any questions submitted to them by the Commission or any member of the Commission, or any of its employees, or any other Person authorized by the Commission for that purpose.

Amendments to the Certificates of Authority come into effect May 12, 2021.
