RESEARCH GRANT AND INDUSTRY DEVELOPMENT FUNDING ORDER

Application

1. To the extent of any conflict or inconsistency between this Order and the Commission's General Order as amended from time to time, the terms of this Order shall prevail.

Eligibility to Apply for Grant or Funding

- 2. Every person who wishes to apply to the Commission for a research grant or for industry development funding must first provide the Commission with:
 - (a) a duly executed Research Grant and Industry Development Funding Pre-Qualification Agreement containing such terms and conditions as the Commission may from time-to-time prescribe; and
 - (b) full and detailed particulars, supported by documentary evidence, of the extent to which the prospective applicant may have authority to represent stakeholders within the British Columbia vegetable industry. Where the prospective applicant is an association or other organization purporting to represent certain industry stakeholders, the prospective applicant agrees to provide the Commission with a full and detailed list of all such industry stakeholders, supported by documents evidencing the agreement or consent of each such industry stakeholder to be so represented by the prospective applicant.

Applications

3. Every application for a research grant or for industry development funding must be made in the form prescribed by the Commission from time-to-time.

Commencement

4. This Order comes into effect on December19, 2024.
